A rollover in the final race of the season failed to upset the charge by Colin Hunter and his Hunter Racing team who have again dominated their class in the Australian Off Road Championship - the fourth year in a row.

Hunter Racing's V8 Jeep Grand Cherokee competes in 'Extreme 4WD' which used to be known as Class Eight and is open to highly modified 4WD vehicles with engines not exceeding 6000c.

The team notched up their fourth consecutive class championship crown at the Albins Off Road Gear Goondiwindi 400, which was run in south-western Queensland over the weekend of October 13-14.

"In the greater scheme of things, though, we had done enough to take the class win for the fourth year in a row, which is a fantastic result and a tribute to the team's passion, commitment and hard work," explained Hunter who has been praising the performance of the Goodyear Wrangler MT/Rs all season.
